This information will enable us to identify Mr. Hicks should he ever again attempt to register in the Scouting program. Thank you for your kind cooperation in this matter.

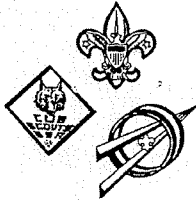
