12-Year Term Given In El Rio Molest Case

An El Rio foster parent received the maximum sentence of 12 years in prison Friday for molesting young boys.

Superior Court Judge James McNally said he found it "necessary to remove (Ed) Bartholomew from society for a long time, the maximum time, in fact." The judge determined

Bartholomew was ineligible for probation, but said he would not have granted that sentence even if it were possible.

Bartholomew, 38, pleaded no contest to two counts of engaging in substantial sexual conduct with a child under 14; two counts of oral copulation with a boy between the ages of 14 and 16, and a charge of furnishing marijuana to a minor.

The charges Bartholomew admitted involved three boys, ages 13 to 15. One was a foster child in the defendant's care.

McNally said Bartholomew has shown "not the slightest willingness" to acknowledge he has a problem and is sexually attracted to young boys. In listing reasons for sentencing Bartholomew to the maximum term, the judge included the violation of trust involved in molesting the foster child.

Foster children already are emotionally troubled, McNally said, "and what they don't need is to be sexually abused on top of whatever problems they might have."

The judge said Bartholomew went out of his way to seek out young boys. Besides being a foster parent, the defendant was an assistant Boy Scout leader.

Bartholomew has been in custody for more than a year. The case took many bizarre twists, including a search of his mother's Port Hueneme home which netted dolls with pins in the hearts and named for law enforcement personnel involved in the case.

Junior High Benefit Spring Concert Set

Advance tickets will be available at all school offices in the Hueneme district. They are \$2.50 for adults and \$1 for children younger than 12, including parking fees. Tickets also may be purchased at the door for \$3 for adults and \$1 for children.

The concert will begin at 7:30 p.m. in the center's auditorium, 575 Surfside Drive, Port Hueneme. Parking is available in the new lot on Surfside Drive adjacent to the Bubbling Springs Park.

pleads no contest in molestation case

A former Boy Scout leader and foster parent pleaded no contest Wednesday to child molestation and drug charges relating to his assaults on several young boys whom he took into his home.

Edward Bruce Bartholomew, 39, Port Hueneeme, entered his no-contest pleas to three counts of child molestation and one count of providing marijuana to a minor just as jurors were to be selected in the case.

Superior Court Judge James McNally had expected to begin jury selection Wednesday afternoon when Bartholomew's attorney, Richard Hanawalt, announced that his client would instead withdraw his previous not-guilty pleas.

Bartholomew faces a possible maximum prison sentence of 12 years, said Deputy District Attorney Rob Ross. He could have faced 17 years had a jury convicted him of all eight charges against him.

Ross said he and his superiors were satisfied with the possible penalty, and said the plea bargain was agreed to out of concern for the young victims who would have had to take the witness stand. The trial had been expected to be a long and complex affair.

Bartholomew complained in court that he was being "nailed to the cross," and that prosecutors went after him on instruction from California authorities because of a Workman's Commensa-

El Rio Man Must Stand Trial in 4th Molestation

An El Rio foster parent already accused of molesting three boys was ordered Monday to stand trial for allegedly having sex with a fourth victim.

Ed Bartholomew, 38, was held to answer on another child molestation count following a preliminary hearing in which a 12-year-old boy testified that the defendant orally copulated him in 1984.

Bartholomew was scheduled to go to trial next week on charges he molested three other boys, ages 13 to 15. Those cases were consolidated into one, even though the alleged victims were discovered separately.

Municipal Court Judge Herb Curtis scheduled Bartholomew's arraignment in Superior Court on the new charge Sept. 2. At that time, the district attorney's office is expected to seek to have the new case consolidated with the others for trial.

Bartholomew's trial date was vacated pending the Sept. 2 hearing. He remains in custody with bail set at \$10,000.

4 More Charges Filed in El Rio Molestation Case

The district attorney's office claims it has found a third victim of an El Rio foster parent already facing trial on charges he molested two young boys.

Four additional child molestation charges were filed Friday against Ed Bartholomew, 38. He also was charged with two counts of furnishing marijuana to a minor and arraignment on the new charges is set for Monday.

Bartholomew is scheduled to go to trial on charges he engaged in oral copulation with two boys, ages 13 and 14, as far back as 1983. He also is charged with furnishing marijuana to one of those boys.

Deputy District Attorney Robert Ross said the victims were boys Bartholomew had in his foster care or took in from the streets. The defendant also was involved in the Boy Scout program, Ross said.

A preliminary hearing on the new charges will be scheduled at Bartholomew's arraignment.

Voodoo dolls found; 3 pierced, labeled

The search this week of a Port Hueneme home for evidence in a child molesting case turned up seven voodoo dolls, a deputy district attorney said Thursday.

Three of the dolls were pierced in the middle with pins and labeled with the names of the prosecutor, investigator and sheriff's deputy involved in the case.

The search, authorized by a warrant signed by Municipal Court Judge Steven Hintz, took place Wednesday in the home of Miriam Bartholomew.

Bartholomew's son, Edward, is in County Jail, Ventura, awaiting trial on multiple charges of molesting young boys.

Investigators obtained the warrant because they suspected that he left items relevant to the case in his mother's home.

Inside the home, court papers indicate, investigators found photographs of nude boys, pornographic magazines, diaries, and newspaper articles about sexual assault cases. They also found the seven voodoo dolls.

Deputy District Attorney Rob Ross said three of the dolls were labeled with the names of Ross, investigator Steven Hunt and a sergeant in the Sheriff's Department.

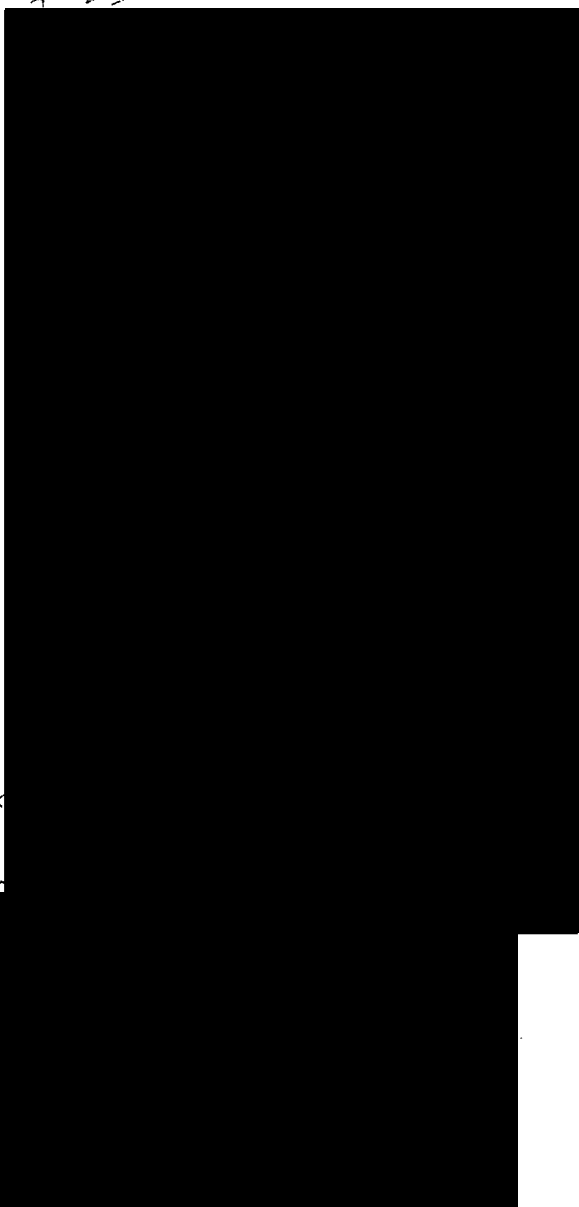
Ross said the dolls have no real relevance in the case against Edward Bartholomew and are not likely to be used as evidence. He admitted, though, that the discovery was a little disconcerting.

"I don't care how superstitious you are, but when someone rolls the contents of a bag out on your desk and it has a doll with your name on it and the doll has a pin in it, it does take your breath away," he said.

"In reality, though, it doesn't have that much effect."

Ross said the allegations against Bartholomew involve incidents when he was a Boy Scout leader and a foster care parent.

The boys range in age from 13 to 15 years old and the incidents go as far back as 1983. Bartholomew's trial is pending in Superior Court. He has been in custody since his arrest.

I am a peace officer for the State of California, employed by the Ventura County Sheriff's Department. On September 18, 1985, the defendant did commit the crime of Oral Copulation, a violation of section 288a(b)(2) P.C. in that he did orally copulate the penis of [REDACTED], a fourteen year old male. This incident occurred at Bartholomew's residence, listed above, which is in the County of Ventura, California.

On 9-18-85, I talked to the victim, [REDACTED]. The following is a summary of what he told me:

He told me that he is a runaway, and that he is now "living on his own." He is living in a trailer in El Rio in the Oxnard area with two other males, one who is fifteen years old and the other who is eighteen years old. [REDACTED] told me that he and numerous other young people, from ten years old on up, "hang out" at Bartholomew's residence. [REDACTED] said that on 9-17-85 at about 10:00p.m. he and a friend went to Bartholomew's residence to visit. [REDACTED] said that he eventually fell

asleep on the couch in the living room and was awakened on 9-18-85 at about 3:00a.m. and found that Bartholomew was orally copulating his [REDACTED] penis. No one else was in the room and Bartholomew was kneeling next to the couch. [REDACTED] said he was surprised and did not know what to do and so he feigned sleep. [REDACTED] said that he ejaculated and was asked by Bartholomew if he liked it. [REDACTED] said that a few minutes, at his first opportunity, he ran from the house.

On 9-25-85 at about 9:20a.m., I had [REDACTED] place a phone call to Bartholomew, which I monitored. [REDACTED] told Bartholomew that he was confused about why he "did that." Bartholomew replied, "Well maybe sometime when you grow up a little bit more maybe we can talk about it..."

[REDACTED] later said, "What I'm trying to ask is why did you give me head?" Bartholomew replied, "Well, now, just hold on a minute. For one, I'm not gonna talk about something like that over the phone and so forth because I think you've got a few facts screwed up." At least three more times during the conversation, [REDACTED] brought up the fact that Bartholomew had given him "head." Bartholomew never admitted to having performed the act, nor did he deny it or question [REDACTED] about what he was talking about. Bartholomew's response was that he would not discuss that with [REDACTED] over the phone but he would discuss it with him in person.

[REDACTED] said, "I need to know whether, if I'm gonna go to the police or not and file a complaint or if I'm just gonna

leave it be, or what." Bartholomew replied, "Well, I think it would be best all the way if you just let it be, just shined it on. Because, ah, it was an, ah, the whole night was an unfortunate mistake."

Bartholomew asked [REDACTED] if he was going to come by. [REDACTED] said he would. Bartholomew asked [REDACTED] to call ahead of time so there would not be a lot of people there. [REDACTED] said, O.K., I know, it would be embarrassing for both of us if anyone found out." Bartholomew answered laughingly, "Ah, that's true."
