Thank you for your response to our recent identification questionnaire concerning John L. Brady, 1472 A. Hamilton, St. Louis, Missouri, who is applying to serve as Scoutmaster of Troop 210. From the information you provided, it is certain that your Mr. Brady is the same individual as one on whom we have information. Mr. Brady was placed with us in July of 1968 while he was serving in the Air Force and stationed at Vandenberg AFB in California. He was placed on the file for reasons of such a serious nature that we will never again, knowingly, be willing to accept his registration in the Scouting program.

When informing Mr. Brady about this, simply tell him that the National Council does not wish to accept his registration in the Boy Scouts of America. If he should raise any questions as to reason, you might indicate to him that registration in the Boy Scouts of America is a privilege and not a right and that the National Council reserves the prerogative to accept those individuals it feels will best serve the interests of the organization.

Investigation of Immoral Behavior against John L. Brady.

Two fathers, with one of their sons, came to see Capt. [REDACTED], Scoutmaster Troop 392. The father of one of the boys said that his son had had relations with John Brady. Capt. [REDACTED] reported this information to Colonel [REDACTED], Chief of Staff, 1st STRATAD. Col. [REDACTED] notified the OSI who presided to investigate. It was found that approximately 12 boys in Troop 392 had had immoral relations with John Brady. This information was turned over to Colonel [REDACTED], JAJ. None of the parents involved would allow their sons to go on a witness stand in a military court martial to testify against Mr. Brady. John Brady, through his squadron commander, turned himself into the hospital, declaring that he was mentally incompetent. He was further evacuated to major AF hospital. These psychiatrists stated that John Brady had confessed his immoral conduct. Findings of the doctors is that he is insane and that the Air Force is now trying some way to discharge him. After his return from the hospital he started coming to troop meetings again and Capt. [REDACTED] reported Brady to his squadron commander, who gave him an Article 15 for disobeying an order.

Subject: Dismissal of John Brady


At the May Committee meeting of Boy Scout Troop 392, a motion was made and unanimously passed to discharge John Brady from his position and duties as assistant Scoutmaster and bar him from all future troop activities. This action resulted from charges of immoral behavior.

Subsequent investigation by the authorities confirmed the charges and in fact John Brady readily admitted to homosexual desires.

Due to the seriousness of the situation, the committee considered it advisable to notify the National Council in the event John Brady should attempt to join another Boy Scout organization at a later date.
